Newark – Home to the University of Delaware, Newark Charter School, W.L. Gore, Bank of America, Newark Country Club, White Clay Creek State Park and numerous shops & restaurants. Adjacent to the MD/DE border with easy access to I-95 and Rt. 40. Philadelphia ~45mins. drive, Baltimore ~60 mins. Drive.

Glasgow/Bear - Suburban area directly on the Rt. 40 corridor and bordered by the Chesapeake & Delaware Canal to the south. Location of Lums Pond State Park, People's Plaza (shopping), Pencader Corporate Center, Fox Run Shopping Center, a new YMCA and a variety of restaurants.
